User's Guide for "Quasi-Valuable Books," Such as *Namazu-e*

The Earthquake Research Institute, University of Tokyo (the "ERI hereafter") basically prohibits loaning the quasi-valuable books in its possession except for the purposes of public utilization (e.g., for use on handbook covers). This rule also applies to reprints, copies and publications of their reproductions.

However, the ERI may permit use of the quasi-valuable books under the following conditions for those who intend to use them for educational or research purposes and have got an introduction from a full or assistant professor at the ERI, provided that the ERI Director General has approved for such use.

You are hereby notified that any use for private or profit is strictly prohibited.

1. Films are to be loaned in place of the books, if there are filmed reproductions of them.
2. CD-ROMs are to be loaned in place of the books, if there are CD-ROM records for them.
3. Originals may be photographed within the ERI Library, if they have no filmed reproductions or CD-ROM records.
4. Reproductions (films, etc.) as made in the preceding paragraph should be presented as a gift to the Library after use.
5. A courtesy remark, such as "this material is in possession of the ERU, University of Tokyo," should be indicated in the publication where the material is made public.
6. Uses other than for the intended purpose are not allowed.
